# What happened in Colombia with the HPV Vaccination program- A story of light and shadows... Happiness and Tears...

### Letter to Editor

In 2012, the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education, both in hands of two admirable women, took the wise and couregous decision of offering the HPV vaccination, free of charge, to all the Colombians school girls aged 9-13. Now it has been extended to 17 years old. 100 million US dollars were invested buying the vaccine through the Panamerican Health Organization (PAHO). A big campaign was planned and the program was launched with enthusiasm across the country in the year 2013. In the first year, we were able to vaccinate 95% of the targeted population!... 95%! Everything went as planned... a great success that was recognized by the entire world... *Aplause! Smiles...! Congratulations...fireworks to celebrate!* 

But in Colombia, happiness seems to be of short duration. In May 2014, in a small village of the Caribbean region, Carmen de Bolivar is the name,15 adolescent girls were admitted to the Emergency Room of the local hospital with bizarre symptoms such as dizziness, headaches, abdominal pain, (some of them fainted on admission), vomiting...nausea. The 15 girls were from the same school and from the same grade. Initially the episode was interpreted as a Food poisoning event. Few hours later, most of the girls were discharged home in good condition. All the young patients mentioned that some months before they had all been vaccinated against the HPV... needless to say, that ALL the girls of the village had been vaccinated, as had been the 95% of the girls in Colombia, as mentioned before.

In the following days, more female youngsters came to the hospital with similar symptoms....up to 550, all of whom had been vaccinated long time before they consulted. Who and why someone blamed the vaccine as the culprit of the symptoms is something that as far as I know, remains in mystery. The truth is that many girls kept on coming seeking medical attention and the capacity of the small local hospital was overwhelmed and chaotic. Suddenly, the media was contacted...news papers, TV Cameras were all over the place interviewing parents, students, and local politicians! And the issue of these girls became National news.

Some lawyers appeared on the scene offering their professional advice on how to sue the government and the pharmaceutical company that produces the vaccine! Millions of dollars were in the imagination of the villagers and the lawyers and then, parents of girls of other cities started to seek some kind of benefit arguing that they also were victims of the vaccine. If they developed lupus... if they developed arthritis, the vaccine was to be blamed! There is even an association of Victims of the HPV vaccine that frequently goes on radio and TV saying that the vaccine is unsafe and discouraging its use.

And to make things worse...the antigovernment politicians started to blame the Government as responsible of the disaster ... that the vaccine that was used was expired...that the proper protocol on vaccination was not followed, etc. To complete the drama...the

We need to empower women to demand what I believe is the most important achievement in modern Oncology...the vaccine against the virus that produces cervical cancer. Vaccination hesitancy is a worldwide problem...and education and Comunication are the only vaccines against ignorance and prejudice.
