**i.** Crime cannot be defined as the elements of Mendeleev's table or the principals of light reflection, mathematics, physics, chemistry, and similar cases that are measurable and testable.

It may be said that there are topics and concepts that all human beings agree on as crimes and we can focus the discussion and study on them, but with a little attention and concentration, we find that homicide, robbery or harming children, elderlies, the disabled

and even destroying the environment, which is expected to be condemned by all cultures and human right organization and known as prosecuted crimes, it can still be overlooked or appreciated by some subcultures and countries in contemporary era. Behaviors of ISIS, depriving girls and women from education and work, encouraging people to internal and external conflicts, all of which are examples of criminal acts based on specific and bizarre definition of humanity and human relation.
